Report:

Background:

Section 284 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001. c.25, requires that the Treasurer of a municipality shall in each year, on or before March 31, provide to the Council of the municipality an itemized statement of the remuneration and expenses paid in the previous year to the following:

- (a) each member of council in respect of his or her services as a member of the council or any other body, including a local board, to which the member has been appointed by council or on which the member holds office by virtue of being a member of council;
- (b) each member of council in respect of his or her services as an officer or employee of the municipality or other body described in clause (a); and
- (c) each person, other than a member of council, appointed by the municipality to serve as a member of any body, including a local board, in respect of his or her services as a member of the body.

Analysis:

The revised attached Council remuneration and expenses statement reflects updated remuneration, including compensation received by Councillor Elphick through participation on the South Bruce OPP Detachment Board.

The updated statement details a total of **\$179,059.97** paid to Members of Council and related boards during 2025. This includes:

- \$10,613.40 from Westario Power Inc.
- \$1,671.12 from the Saugeen Valley Conservation Authority
- \$750.00 associated with the South Bruce OPP Detachment Board
