

This is a petition from the residents of Geeson St./Ave in Walkerton. Our street to the south connects with Carrick Brant E and Highway 9 to the north.

When my husband and I moved to Geeson St./Ave in 2011, we noticed that when approaching the Geeson St. corner from either the east or west, it was very difficult to find the corner. We felt that a street light would be very beneficial to light this corner and make it more visible. At the time, Kym Hutcheon was Councillor and I spoke with her about this situation and a street light was installed, however, it was placed on an already fixed pole and it is the distance of 2 hydro poles away from the corner. It's actually lighting the Superior Propane driveway/parking lot which I'm sure they don't mind. The initial problem is still an issue.

When Chris Peabody was campaigning for the Mayoral position on our street, I approached him about a street light at the end of our street and why the 2011 requested light was installed where it went. He informed me that a new transformer would have had to be installed to place a light at the corner, which apparently was a very costly procedure. No one bothered to inform us of why it was put where it is. Chris suggested we petition our street for a solar powered light.

When petitioning our street, many of the residents mentioned that they too have trouble finding the said corner within town limits and were very much in agreement that a light would be most welcomed. In fact, residents also would

request a light be installed at the corner of Chiropractor, Dr. Batte , Carrick Brant E and Hwy 9 (which runs north and south)

We the residents of Geeson St./Ave are proposing and requesting that a solar powered street light be installed at the said corners to alleviate poor visibilty and eliminate a safety issue..

Statements of Residents:

- ★ “These are dangerous corners - surely a life is worth more than a light”
- ★ “It’s difficult enough to see the corners in the dark at the best of times but if we’re having fog, heavy rain, snow or blowing snow, it’s a different story.”
- ★ Someone visiting a residence , “I never know where that corner is!”
- ★ Many times, while speaking with the residents, they told me that they turned down the trail thinking that was the corner.
