The Municipality of Brockton is inviting proposals for the procurement of a qualified and competent Consulting Engineering Firm to Complete a Municipal *Rural* Roads Condition and Needs Assessment Study.

The study will assist in providing the Municipality with a comprehensive Rural Roads Condition and Needs Assessment that will in turn aid and inform the Municipality's Capital Asset Management Plan and guide future Capital Project planning (0 to 5 year, 6 to 10 years, 11 to 20 years). Cost estimate comparisons by construction and surface treatment types, when developing a budget, will be an important component of the final report to Brockton Municipal Council. The Final presentation of your completed report will take place on Tuesday September 10th, 2019 at the Brockton Municipal Council Meeting.

A Request For Proposal (RFP), which includes instructions for its completion, is attached.
