Ross and Associates Limited for the purpose of performing the 2019 Rural Roads Needs and Conditions Assessment.

Report:

Background:

At the May 14, 2019 Council Meeting, staff presented Report Number PW2019-22, proposing that Brockton Council authorize staff to enter into an agreement with B.M. Ross and Associated Limited to perform a Rural Roads Needs and Condition Assessment project (based on RFP 2019-02) valued at \$23,961. The pre-approved budget for the project is \$25,000. Brockton Council approved Resolution 19-10-11 awarding the project to B.M. Ross and Associates Limited. A copy of Resolution 19-10-11 has been attached to this report for Council's information.

Analysis:

As per Resolution 19-10-11, staff have contacted B.M. Ross and Associates Limited to start the project given the tight timelines. B.M. Ross and Associates Limited has prepared a standard Municipal Engineers Association (MEA)/ Consulting Engineers of Ontario (CEO) Agreement between themselves and the Municipality of Brockton. Staff require that a By-Law be brought forward, executing this agreement.
