#### Report:

#### **Background:**

The Brockton Police Service Board has received a Reduce Impaired Driving Everywhere (R.I.D.E.) Grant Allocation from the Ministry of the Solicitor General yearly. This grant is intended to enhance the regular R.I.D.E. program currently being conducted by the Ontario Provincial Police South Bruce (Brockton) to offset the costs for sworn officers' overtime and paid duty.

#### **Analysis**:

On June 11, 2019, the Brockton Police Service Board received a letter from the Ministry of the Solicitor General regarding the R.I.D.E. Grant Allocation for 2019-2020. The letter has been attached to this report for Council's information.

The Brockton Police Service Board has been granted an allocation of \$8,853.00 under the R.I.D.E. Grant Program for the 2019-2020 fiscal year. The agreement covers the period from April 1, 2019 to March 31, 2020.

Staff are recommending that a By-Law come forward to adopt the R.I.D.E. Grant Program Agreement. The agreement must be adopted by July 31, 2019.
