## **CONDITIONS OF THE PERMIT**

- 1. This permit is for the use of raw water samples from the Lake Rosalind Small Municipal Drinking Water Treatment Facility (DWS 220007800), owned by the Municipality of Brockton, but operated and maintained under contract by Veolia North America, for the sole purpose of performing Microbial Source Tracking study work as related ONLY to Mr. Avedesian's Master's work with the University of Guelph.
- 2. This permit does not allow access to any facilities owned or operated by the Municipality of Brockton.
- 3. All permits for research from provincial, federal and other agencies must be obtained and remain valid prior to and during the proposed research. If found to be lacking, this permit and the relationship between the Municipality and permitee will be immediately terminated and made null and void.
  - Please be advised that this permit does not relieve you of any other applicable provincial, federal or municipal licenses, permits, regulations by-laws or requirements. As a result, all necessary permits and approvals must have been obtained from other agencies to complete this work.
- 4. Raw water samples are to be collected by Veolia North America staff or staff of the Municipality of Brockton, not the permitee.
- 5. Upon completion of this study and permit, any and all materials left at the site must be picked up by the permitee within 30 days of the end of the expiration date of this permit.
- 6. The area used is to be left in a clean and undamaged condition, in the same or better condition than it was found in.
- 7. No use of motorized equipment is permitted on the property.
- 8. Any vehicles to the site are not to block a roadway or gate entrance
- You must comply with all Municipal Bylaws and Provincial, and Federal Acts and Regulations.
- 10. The Municipality of Brockton must be contacted/ consulted and provided a copy of any draft material before any information is published about its water system. Any and all location references and references to the Municipality of Brockton, Council Members, staff from the Municipality of Brockton, and Contractors of the Municipality of Brockton shall be removed from any publications and presentations.
- 11. Once approved by the Municipality, that a copy of all final publications be provided to the Municipality of Brockton at the same time as any and all other actual or perceived stakeholders.

- 12. The Permitee and the University of Guelph shall indemnify and save harmless the Municipality of Brockton, its staff, Council Members, and Contractors from and against all liability under such Statutes, Laws and Regulations and in respect of all claims, fines, suits, demands that may arise or be made against the Municipality at common law, equity or otherwise by reason of injury or death of any person or persons, or employee, or employees of yourself, or site users. Mr. Avedesian and the University of Guelph shall indemnify and save harmless the Municipality of Brockton from and against all damage or lost equipment
- 13. Failure to comply with these conditions will result in termination of this permit and will affect subsequent request/renewals.
