### **Background:**

On June 4, 2019, GM BluePlan issued a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Schedule 'B' Notice of Completion after Brockton Resolution 19-12-07 was passed authorizing the removal of Bridge 11, Greenock at the Brockton Council Meeting on Tuesday, May 28, 2019.

The Notice of Completion was advertised in the Hanover Post, The Walkerton Herald Times, and the Municipal Website as well as mailed to neighbouring residents of Bridge 11, Greenock.

#### **Analysis:**

Attached are letters received from members of the public. The comments have been forwarded to GM BluePlan pursuant to the process, however as the comments do not pertain to the environmental assessment, staff have reached out to GM BluePlan to ensure that the comments will not impose a Part II order. Staff have also confirmed that no Part II Order requests have been submitted to the Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks. The deadline for requests to be received was July 4, 2019.

Andrea Nelson, Senior Hydrogeologist from GM BluePlan Engineering and Tayler Grubb, CAO/Operations Administrative Assistant will be working together to complete an information bulletin for residents to address

their comments and concerns. Otherwise, staff have attached for Council's review and responding letter to be sent to the individuals that submitted comments.
