Report:

Background:

On May 13, 2019, the Municipality submitted an application for the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program (ICIP): Rural and Northern Stream grant for the reconstruction of Bridge 13, located in Greenock, Concession 8. The GM BluePlan Engineering report attached outlines the structural repairs that are needed in the near future. Receiving this grant would provide substantial financial benefits to the reconstruction of Bridge 13.

Total project cost estimate to be \$1,395,000 plus a 15% contingency of \$209,250, for a total cost of \$1,604,250.

Analysis:

On July 24, 2019 staff received information that our application has been nominated under the Rural and Northern funding stream of Ontario’s Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program (case number referenced above) to the Federal government for review and approval. As this is a federal program, the provincial

government cannot guarantee approval of the application. All final funding decisions are made by the Federal government, and this notification should not be construed as providing approval. Staff will continue to provide council with updates as they are received.
