### **Report:**

#### Background:

On September 10, 2019 staff presented Report Number CLK2019-27, providing Council with information about a request from the St. Thomas Anglican Church to obtain a Heritage Loan for the replacement of their roof. Council approved By-Law 2019-105 authorizing the Heritage loan agreement with St. Thomas Anglican Church.

Following the Council Meeting, staff contacted St. Thomas Anglican Church to inform them of Council's decision.

#### Analysis:

On September 18, 2019, staff received an email from Christine Brandt, the Warden of St. Thomas Anglican Church, respectfully declining the Heritage Loan. The Church will instead borrow the necessary funds from within their organization. This email has been attached to this report for Council's information.

As a result of the Church's decline of the loan, staff have prepared a By-Law to rescind By-Law 2019-105.
