





DETACHMENT UPDATES

- There were no Sexual Assaults reported during this time period.
- Assaults are down slightly during this time period compared to 2018 and continue to be down Year to Date.
- Break and Enters, Theft Over and Under all continue to trend downward for the month of October and Year to Date.
- We saw an increase in Frauds this month but remain status quo Year to Date. Two
 frauds involved bogus on-line offers of Governments grants. Others involved overdue
 invoice notices, e-transfers and on-line purchases. One involved an individual's cell
 phone being "ported" and the suspects changing passwords and attempting to access
 account information.
- Mischiefs are status quo this year compared to last. There is no identifiable trend in the mischiefs that have occurred in the past month. Youths have been identified as possible suspects for mischief to a County bridge and at the Rotary Park pavilion. One mischief involved a smashed mailbox, another was a damaged bench at a cemetery. Another was air let out of a vehicle's tires. In one instance, alarm wires were cut at a Laundromat likely as a pretense to a Break and Enter Laundromats are known targets throughout the area.
- There was one Personal Injury Motor Vehicle Collision this month with the injuries being minor. Property Damage collisions were status quo from the previous year but we continue to be down overall Year to Date.
- South Bruce OPP officers participated in the Fall Seatbelt Campaign and Operation
 Impact over the Thanksgiving Long Weekend contributing to making our highways safer.
 Twenty-three seatbelt charges were laid during the Seatbelt Campaign. Sixty-two
 charges were laid over the Holiday weekend.

- Complaints of speeding on Geeson Avenue were explored. It is noted that there is no speed signs on this stretch of roadway and therefore it is not enforceable.
 Recommendation has been made to the Municipality to erect speed signs to assist in this area.
- S/Sgt RICHARDSON attended the Walkerton Remembrance Day Ceremony on November 11th and laid the wreath on behalf of the Brockton PSB.
