1. Walkerton Business Improvement Area Annual General Meeting

Councillor Hutcheon invited all members of Council to the Walkerton Business Improvement Area Annual General Meeting on December 4, 2019 at 6:30 p.m.

2. Commitment to Modular Reactors

Deputy Mayor Gieruszak informed Council that the Province has announced support for small modular reactors, the first of which will likely be operational in 2022. Deputy Mayor Gieruszak provided notice of a motion to be considered at the next Council meeting that the Municipality of Brockton initiate discussions

with the Canadian Nuclear Safety Association, the Province of Ontario, the Government of Canada, Bruce Power, and the Nuclear Innovation Institute, to determine the feasibility and interest in establishing within the Municipality of Brockton a Centre of Excellence in the model of the Walkerton Clean Water Centre to ensure regulatory safety and training in the small modular reactors.

3. Applus+ Launch

Councillor Adams informed Council of the Applus+ event and expressed excitement at having a business with such potential to create jobs located in Walkerton.
