VJH Accomplishments in 2019:

- Hosted 23 events in the Opera Hall, with over 5000 attendees
- Restored 4 large windows, and covered them with insulated glass
- Performed a major overhaul on our elevator
- Provided seasonal lighting on the Hall Tower and gazebo
- Completely redone Suite 5, with the help of County Towne Players
- Restored the original Walkerton Council Boardroom Table (in Suite 5)
- Developed new volunteers to enhance our complement of over 60 people

How has Council's assistance helped?

- Momentum the increased funding gives a sense of being appreciated, to the army of volunteers who keep the Hall running on a shoestring, and to donors who generously support our efforts.
- In simple dollars the unavoidable repair to the elevator which cost over \$4000.

Plans for 2020

- Major repair to the east side porch roof (~\$8000)
- Repair to sinking sidewalk on west side (in conjunction with Brockton Works)
- Restore and insulate 4 more windows
- Upgrade sound and light systems for the stage, and training for techs
- Seal and weatherproof 3 basement windows
- Develop improved Website presence and Social Media skills
