## Personal Statements & Information

I have been a resident of Brockton since my parents moved to the 6<sup>th</sup> concession of Brant Township when I was 16. After graduating from Walkerton & District Secondary School I obtained an honours BSc degree with a geology major from the University of Waterloo. I have taken computer and accounting courses from Georgian College over the years as well.

As a geologist I have worked across Canada, in the USA and Zimbabwe. Much of the work has been as a consultant supervising large field programs. I have experience in budget preparations, tracking and monitoring. I am a 30 plus year member of the Canadian Institute of Mining, Metallurgy and Petroleum as well as a member of the Prospectors & Developers Association of Canada. I also spent over 15 years working on residential environmental programs on home energy, water and waste reduction.

I am a founding member of the Architectural Conservancy of Ontario - South Bruce-Grey Branch. In 1997 the ACO South Bruce-Grey Branch took over management and restoration of Victoria Jubilee Hall. I have been involved in the operation and management of VJH since then. I sat on the planning committee representing the ACO during the restoration of the Dance Pavilion in Kincardine. I was also a member of the Provincial Council of the ACO for 6 years.

From 1996 to 2011 I volunteered with the 1<sup>st</sup> Walkerton Scouts in both leadership and administration positions.
