Report:

Background:

Brockton's 2018-2022 Committees of Council are undergoing a turnover period. Some Committees sought additional members to assist with quorum; others are hoping to attract members with particular expertise. As a result, staff advertised Committee Members vacancies on the municipal website, social media, and the Brockton Buzz Newsletter, and received interested applicants.

Staff have prepared a By-Law amending the 2018-2022 Council Committee Appointment By-Law with corresponding changes. This By-Law has been attached to the report for Council's information.

Analysis:

Due to the Committee Member vacancy advertisement, some Committee received many applications, including applicants after the deadline of January 30, 2020. These Committees wish to discuss the applications received. Therefore, staff predict that another amendment to the 2018-2022 Council Committee Appointment By-Law will come forward in March 2020, should Council agree with the Committee's recommendations.
