Report:

Background:

Council gave By-Law 2018-082 – Russell Municipal Drain By-Law first and second reading, and provisionally adopted the By-Law on November 5, 2018. Staff prepared the By-Law for third and final reading, which was adopted by Council on February 11, 2020.

Staff were provided with the tender for the Russell Municipal Drain from R.J. Burnside and Associates Limited on January 22, 2020. Staff advertised the tender for the Russell Municipal Drain on the municipal website. Tenders were received until Tuesday, February 11, 2020 at 12:00 Noon. A copy of the tender is attached to this report for Council's information.

Analysis:

Tenders for the Russell Municipal Drain were opened on Tuesday, February 11, 2020 at 12:00 Noon at the Brockton Municipal Office. One (1) tender was received, and was opened by Fiona Hamilton, Clerk, Sarah Johnson, Junior Deputy Clerk, Ray Holliday, Chief Building Official and Ed DeLay, R.J. Burnside and Associates Limited.

Ed DeLay, M.Eng. P.Eng of R.J. Burnside and Associates Limited reviewed the tender that was submitted for the construction of the Russell Municipal Drain 2018 and recommends that the Council of the Municipality of Brockton award the tender to Van Gorp Farm Drainage Ltd.

Staff have prepared a By-Law accepting the tender of Van Gorp Farm Drainage Ltd in the amount of \$56,504.00 plus H.S.T. for the construction of the Russell Municipal Drain.
