The following report summarizes operational data, maintenance activities, and compliance issues identified during the Operating Month of February 2020.

All three water treatment Systems (Chepstow, Lake Rosalind, and Walkerton) had an official Ministry of Environment, Conservation, and Parks Inspection. The reports for Chepstow and Lake Rosalind have now been received with a 100% compliance rating each. We are currently awaiting the Walkerton Inspection Report however we are not anticipating any compliance issues. A summary report will be forthcoming in April.
