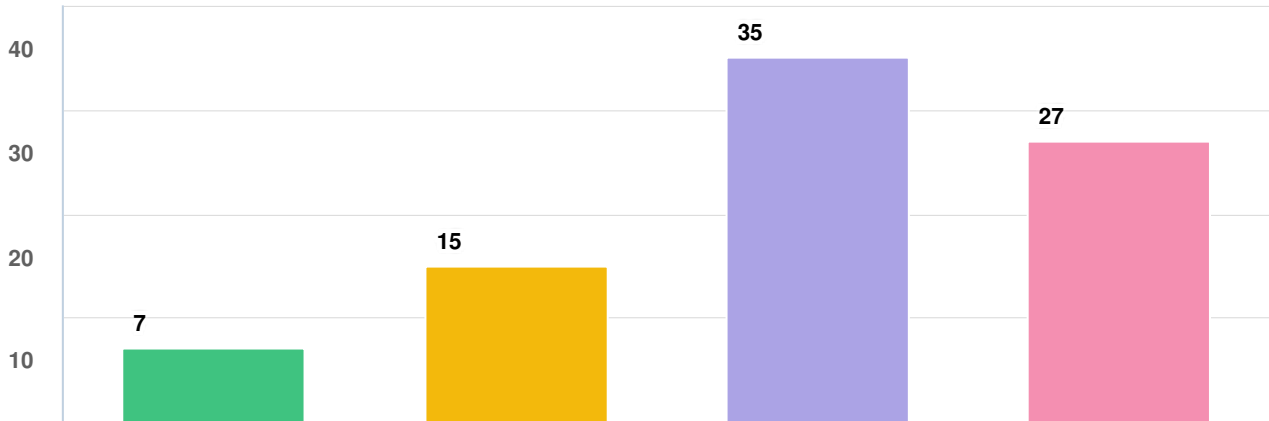

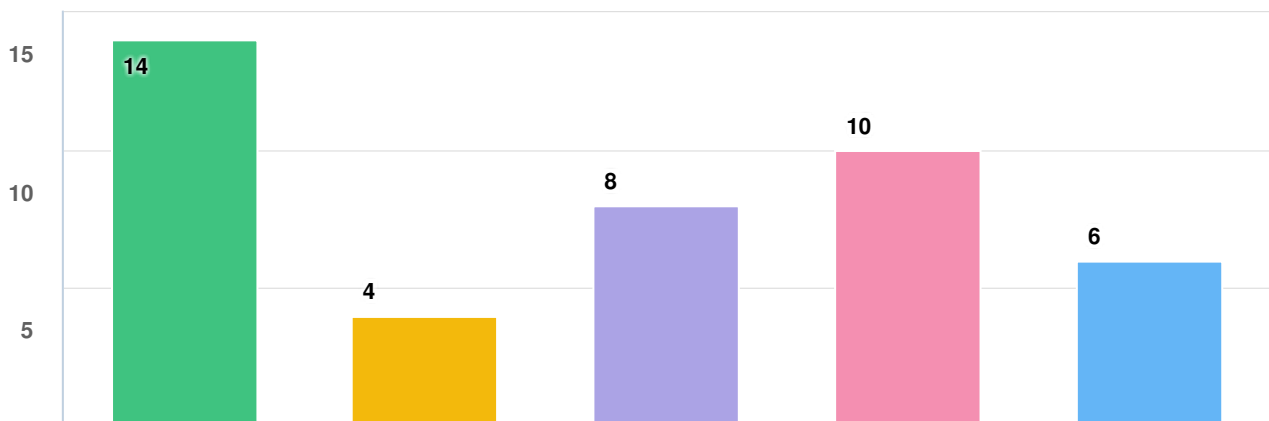
Which of the following best describes the impact of COVID-19 on your business right now?

- Impact is very significant and growing fast

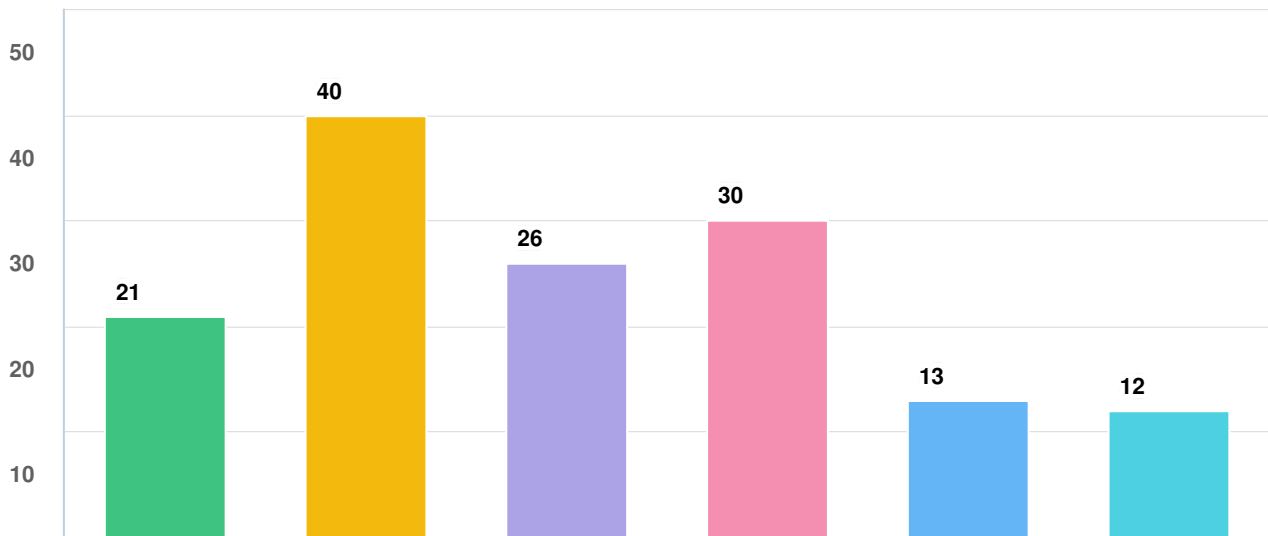
What current measures have you put in place to address the economic impact of the COVID-19 pandemic?

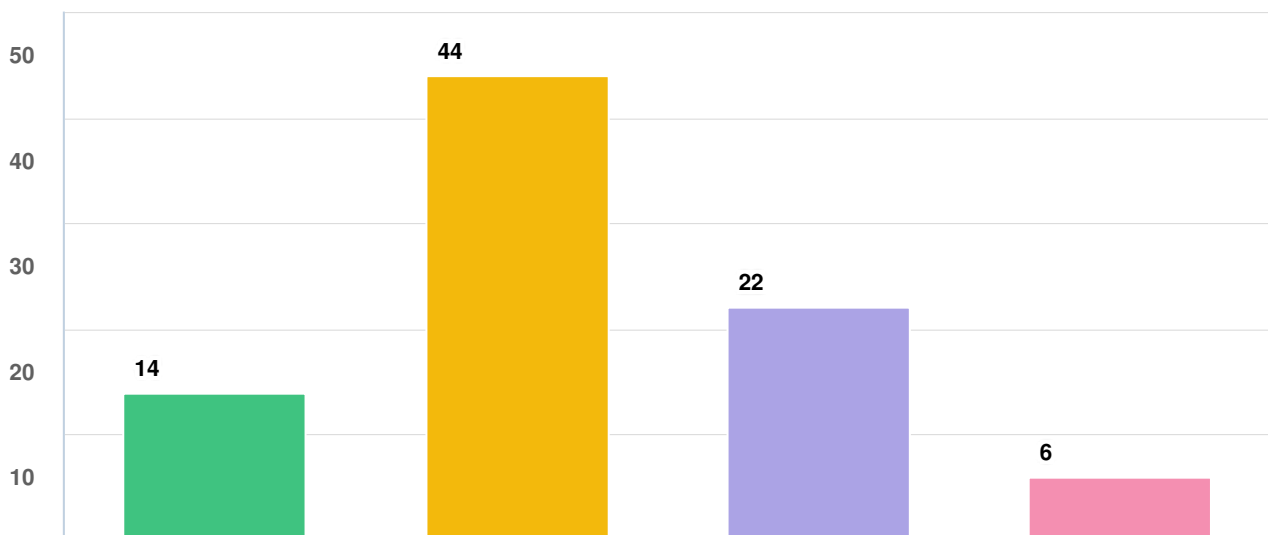

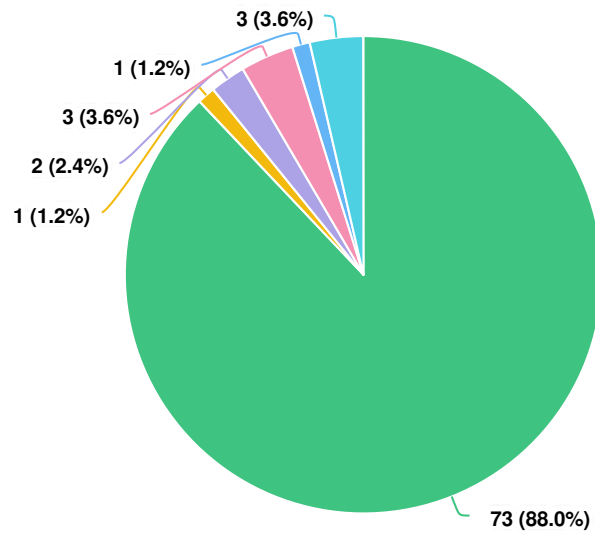
### If you have completed a cash flow projection for the next 6 months, what best describes your situation?

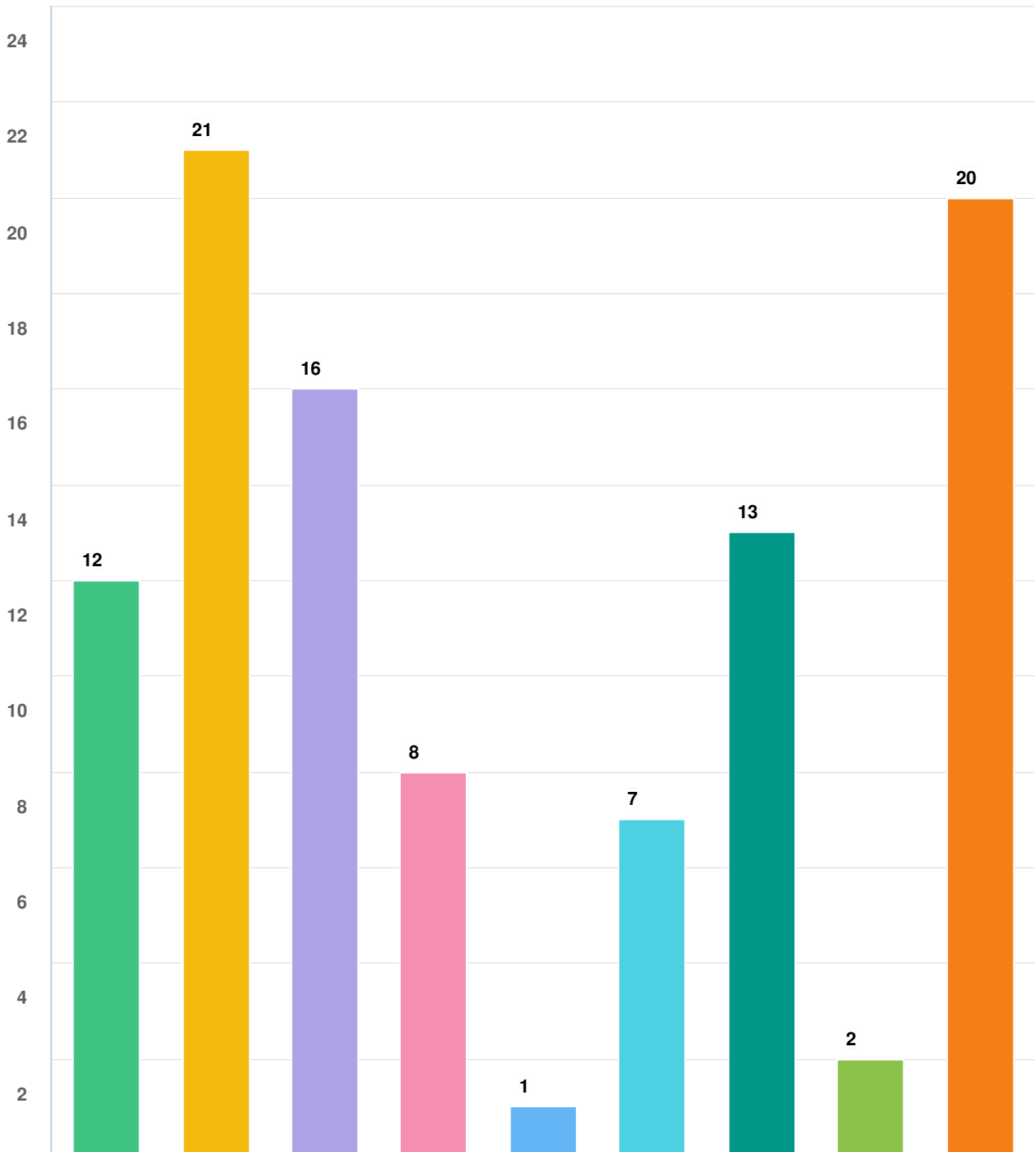

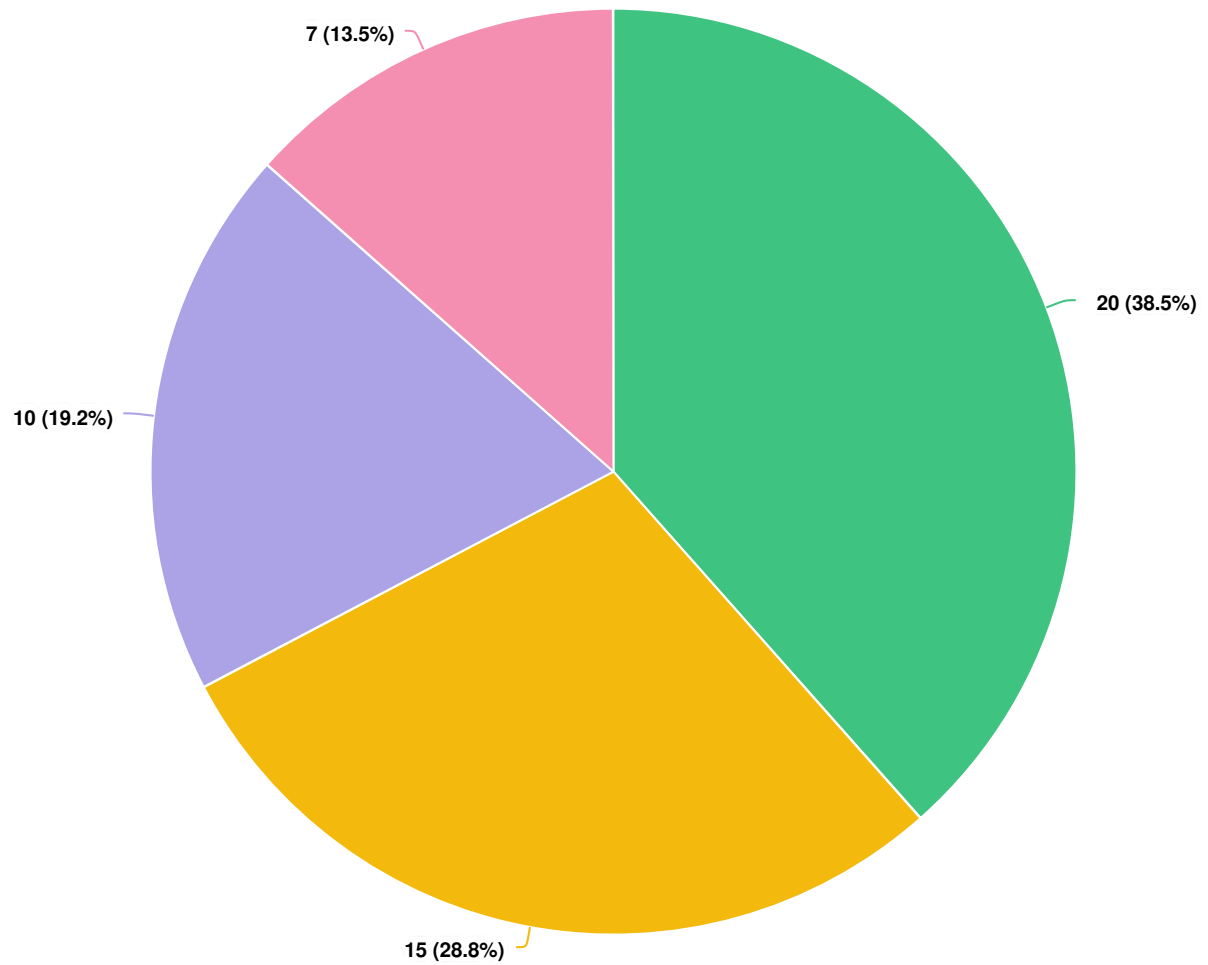
