Report:

Background:

The Council of the Municipality of Brockton were originally scheduled to meet on June 16th and June 30^{th,} 2020 for regular Council Meetings.

Analysis:

The original Council Meeting dates of June 16th and June 30th were established in order to accommodate staff attending the AMCTO Conference; however, the conference has been cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

In addition, several urgent matters require direction prior to June 16th. There would also be a period of two (2) to three (3) weeks in between the May 26th and June 16th Council Meetings; therefore, staff are proposing rescheduling the Council Meeting dates to accommodate for these matters in order to continue operations and ratify decisions in a timely manner.

The June 16th Council Meeting is proposed to be rescheduled to June 9th, and the June 30th Council Meeting is proposed to be rescheduled to June 23rd.

If Council approves the rescheduled meeting dates, communication will be distributed to inform the public, the County of Bruce (for planning matters), and any previously scheduled delegations.
