### **Report:**

### Background:

On September 10, 2019 Stephen Cobean, Drainage Superintendent brought forward Report DRAIN2019-02, and Council passed By-Law 2019-099 appointing Dietrich Engineering Limited as the Engineering Company for the Koelen Municipal Drain.

On February 19, 2020 an Information Meeting was held at the Brockton Municipal Office with the landowners and agencies to review the type and design of drainage system, estimated costs, and proposed assessment. The Information Meeting provided information about the plans for the Engineer's Report prior to it being filed with the Municipality of Brockton.

#### Analysis:

On March 26, 2020 the Municipality received the Engineer's Report on the Koelen Municipal Drain. Upon receipt of the report, a Notice of Meeting to Consider the Engineer's Report was distributed to landowners and agencies in accordance with the *Drainage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. D.17.* A copy of the report, and the Notice of Meeting to Consider the Engineer's Report are attached to this report for Council's information.

Engineer, Greg Nancekivell of Dietrich Engineering Limited is attending the June 23, 2020 Council Meeting as a delegation to present his report on the Koelen Municipal Drain.

Staff have prepared a By-Law to provisionally adopt the Koelen Municipal Drain. If approved, the By-Law will come back at a future Council meeting for third and final reading.
