NOTICE OF IMPENDING LANE CLOSURES

LOBIES BRIDGE REPAIRS

This notice is being issued to advise residents and local business owners of impending lane restrictions on Yonge Street North to facilitate repairs to Lobies Bridge, which spans the Saugeen River in the community of Walkerton.

It is anticipated that the lane restrictions will occur between June and November, 2020 and extend for a period of approximately 2 months. One lane will remain open for vehicle access at all times. Access to the Saugeen River Trail, which is located at the south end of the bridge, may be restricted during some components of the bridge work.

Pedestrian access over the bridge may be restricted during the first 5 weeks of the construction period, however the Municipality is investigating options to provide additional pedestrian options.
