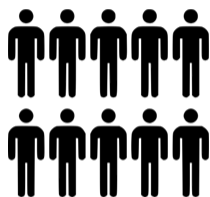


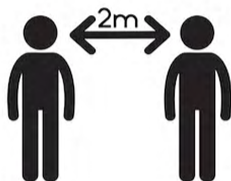


# Ready. Set. Play.
