

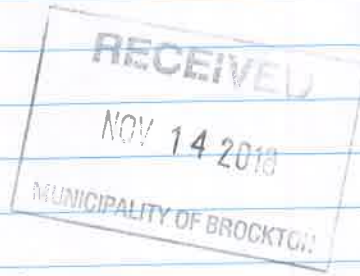


Oct. 31/2018

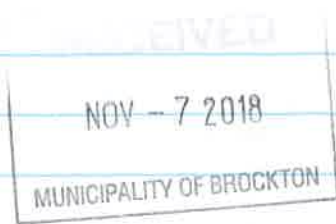

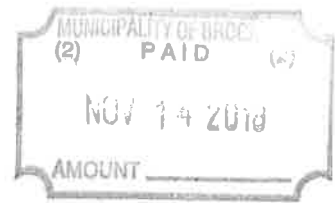

CAN'T BE EVERYWHERE AT THE SAME TIME

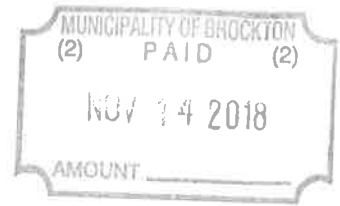
