Report:

Background:

Council gave By-Law 2020-077 – Koelen Municipal Drain By-Law first and second reading, and provisionally adopted the By-Law on June 23, 2020. Staff prepared the By-Law for third and final reading, which was adopted by Council on August 25, 2020.

Staff were provided with the tender for the Koelen Municipal Drain from Dietrich Engineering Limited on August 14, 2020. Staff advertised the tender for the Koelen Municipal Drain on the municipal website. Tenders were received until Friday, September 4, 2020 at 12:00 Noon. A copy of the tender is attached to this report for Council's information.

Analysis:

Tenders for the Koelen Municipal Drain were opened on Friday, September 4, 2020 at 12:00 Noon via Zoom Video Conferencing. X tenders were received and were opened by Fiona Hamilton, Clerk, Sarah Johnson, Jr. Deputy Clerk, Ray Holliday, Chief Building Official, Jessica Reinhart, Jr. Deputy Treasurer, and Greg Nancekivell, Dietrich Engineering Limited.

Mr. Nancekivell, of Dietrich Engineering Limited reviewed the tenders submitted for the construction of the Koelen Municipal Drain 2020 and recommends that the Council of the Municipality of Brockton award the tender to Robinson Farm Drainage Limited.

Staff have prepared a By-Law accepting the tender of Robinson Farm Drainage Limited in the amount of \$39,098.00 plus H.S.T. for the construction of the Koelen Municipal Drain.
