



# **DETACHMENT UPDATES**

- We continue on a good trend with no Sexual Assaults reported Year to Date.
- The number of Assault complaints continue to remain status quo compared to February 2019.
- Break and Enters are down slightly.
- Theft Over and Under complaints continue to be down from last year at this time.
- Frauds are down significantly thus far this year. March is Fraud Prevention Month. Our Community Safety Officer has increased our messaging and education around frauds and scams.
- Mischief reports are up slightly. One was due to a vehicle being entered, one was a broken window, one involved damage to a lighting sensor. Mischief charges were also laid against a prisoner who damaged police equipment while in custody.
- Personal injury collisions are down for the month of February.
- Property damage collisions were up for the month of February although we are still down Year to Date.
- The third Human Trafficking Awareness Session took place at the Davidson Centre in Kincardine on March 5th. There was standing room only with 135 people in attendance. All three sessions have been extremely well received by the community. The Committee will be meeting in April to establish our plan for the 2<sup>nd</sup> year of the grant.

- The Community Safety and Well Being (CSWB) Committee has launched a website, <u>cswbp-brucegrey.ca</u>. This website will provide community members with information about the CSWB planning process and progress. Community Engagement has started with the additional launch of the Community Safety and Well Being survey. This survey can be accessed via the website and is open until March 22<sup>nd</sup>. Two Community Engagement Sessions are planned for Brockton on the following dates:
