The following report summarizes operational data, maintenance activities, and compliance issues identified during the Operating Month of October 2020.

Analysis:

There were no compliance or regulatory issues in relation to the operations or maintenance of the three (3) water treatment facilities or the wastewater treatment plant.

The Chepstow Drinking Water System had its Ministry of the Environment, Conservation, and Parks (MOECP) inspection in September and received a 100% compliance rating.

The Walkerton Drinking Water System had its MOECP inspection in October and we are awaiting the results.
