5. ITEMS FOR DECISION/DISCUSSION

5.1 Site Operations

 The Committee reviewed a cost comparison of municipal staff versus contract based upon actual costs from May 1st, 2019 to April 30th, 2020 which showed comparable costs.

The Committee agreed with the municipal staffing as a way of containing costs.

5.2 Styrofoam Recycling

 The Committee discussed the mobile unit by Second Wind Recycling that densifies polystyrene onsite which would be viable if there were five municipalities participating in the area.

The Committee subsequent approved the following motion.

THAT the Hanover/Walkerton Waste Management Committee recommend a test trial to densify polystyrene from both trailers at the Hanover Walkerton landfill and the Walkerton Recycling Centre to a maximum cost of \$3,000.00.

There would be an invitation to other municipalities to view the densification process.

6.1 2020 Landfill Quantities

 The Committee reviewed the landfill monthly quantities to August 31st overall quantities reviewed has increased by 17.6% as compared to 2019

6.2 Landfill Operation Report

• The Committee reviewed the landfill site operations report for July and August with no concerns noted or expressed.

6.3 2020 Landfill Budget

• The committee reviewed the budget status to August 31st, 2020 which revenues are currently at 95% and 98% of annual projections for cash customers and commercial accounts.

6.4 Cell No.2 Construction

 Ron Cooper reported that Cell No.2 was substantially completed on September 9th. Capping of the north side of Cell No.1 which was included in the tender has yet to be completed.

6.5 HHW Event – October 17, 2020

- The Household Hazardous Waste Event will be held on October 17th at the Hanover Public Works Yard 70-14th Avenue from 10:00am to 2:00pm for both Hanover and Walkerton residents to attend.
- Notices are being placed on both municipalities websites, social media and in local newspapers for October 8th.

- Bruce Davidson to discuss with Smitty's to deliver to Hanover/Walkerton landfill site and potentially enter into a fee for service contract.
