The Committee has also mentioned that it may be better able to achieve its vision as a separate notfor-profit as it may allow the Committee greater flexibility in budgeting and fundraising. Furthermore, as Sustainability was identified as a core pillar in the Strategic Plan, it is recommended that every Committee consider ways to undertake their mandate with environmental stewardship in mind rather than having only one Committee tasked with advising on matters of global concern. Recommendation: That this Committee be dissolved as a Committee of Council and that staff provide support to facilitate a transition to other models for this group of volunteers if required.
