The objective of this project is to design, consult and build a connecting space from the Catherine Street Municipal Parking lot to the downtown core of Walkerton via the undeveloped Durham Street Park lot secured by the municipality in 2020, situated between Walker's Landing Pub & Eatery and the RE/MAX Office.
