That the Council of the Municipality of Brockton hereby receives Report Number UT2021-02 - Walker West Estates Water Booster Pumping Station Generator Set Quotations, prepared by Gregg Furtney, Director of Operations and further approves the purchase of the Stamford, UC1274D Sommers Generator System in the amount of \$60,901.35 (HST included) as recommended by BM Ross and Associates.

Report:

Background:

The Walker West Estates subdivision requires a backup generator for the Water Booster Pumping Station. BM Ross and Associates are handling the design and tendering for this project, on behalf of the Municipality. A diesel backup generator is necessary for all water and wastewater related facilities. BM Ross and Associates have tendered for a suitable backup diesel generator and have received three (3) written quotes in return.

Analysis:

BM Ross and Associates have tendered for and have received three (3) written quotes for a diesel backup generator for the Walker West Estates Water Booster Pumping Station. Upon review of the returned quotations, BM Ross and Associates are recommending that the Municipality of Brockton purchase the Stamford UC1274D Sommers Generator System in the amount of \$60,901.35 (including HST). This was also the lowest quote of the three (3) submissions. The Municipality of Brockton already has a number of Sommers Generator Systems connected to various water and wastewater facilities and, to date, have been quite pleased with the product and its reliability.

Therefore, staff are also recommending the purchase of the Stamford UC1274D backup Diesel Sommers Generator System for this project.
