That the Council of the Municipality of Brockton hereby receives Report Number PW2021-04 – Grey Transportation Route (GTR) Memorandum of Understanding, prepared by Cally Mann, Municipal Executive Coordinator, and in doing so approves a By-Law coming forward to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with Grey County.

Report:

Background:

On September 8, 2020, staff brought Report PW2020-26 – Grey Transit Route: Durham to Walkerton to Council regarding the implementation of a bus route between Flesherton, Durham, Hanover and Walkerton.

This bus route runs on Mondays and Fridays, making four round trips a day, starting at 7am and ending at 7pm. Since its launch on October 5, 2020, there have been 39 riders. Nine (9) riders or 23% of the pickup's and six (6) riders or 15% of the drop offs have been in Walkerton. As the service runs only two days a week at this time, it has only been in service for 34 days over the last four (4) months

The bus stop in Walkerton is located at the 306 Scott Street Municipal Parking Lot.

Analysis:

Grey County staff have drafted the attached Memorandum of Understanding to grant permission for Grey County to operate the Grey Transportation Route (GTR) within Brockton. Permission has been granted through a previous Council motion on September 8, 2020, and the signing of this Memorandum of Understanding is the final step.

Staff is recommending that Council accept and approve the signing of the Memorandum of Understanding with Grey County.
