





- A minimum of 10 RIDE programs were conducted during the month of February.
- There were no Impaired Driving or Over 80 charges this month but one 3 day suspension was issued.
- A minimum of 10 traffic complaint were received.

DETACHMENT UPDATES

- Sexual Assault and Assaults so far this year are trending downward.
- The Crimes Against a Person were Criminal Harassment and Threatening investigations.
- There were no Break and Enters reported during this time period.
- Of note, two individuals were arrested in Perth County and charged with 7 multijurisdictional Break and Enters. One of those Break and Enters was to a Brockton business in January. Charges have been laid accordingly.
- The Theft Unders were minor in nature. Charges were laid in one occurrence, one was deemed unfounded and another was solved but the complainant declined charges.
- There were no other notable property Crime offences this month.
- March is Fraud Prevention month. We have conducted radio interviews and been present on Social media with Fraud prevention messaging and education.
- Motorized Snow Machine patrols continued on our local trails. Over 700 sledders have been checked so far between the patrol and stationary RIDE at the trail heads. 7 charges have been laid, 1 Alcohol Screening test completed and 3 warnings issued. Officers also assisted a stranded rider during their patrols.
