#### **Recommendation:**

That the Council of the Municipality of Brockton hereby receives Report Number PW2021-09 – George Street Reconstruction Tender Results, prepared by Gregg Furtney, Director of Operations, for information purposes and further approves awarding the project to Kurtis Smith Excavating Inc. in the amount of \$808,854, including HST.

### **Report:**

#### **Background:**

There have been four (4) water main breaks on George Street, three (3) in 2020 (July 6, August 13, September 2) and one (1) in 2021 (February 19).

Council approved, in the 2021 Capital Budget, the reconstruction of George Street along with stormwater, sanitary sewer, and watermain replacement for a combined total of \$875,000.

BM Ross and Associates were contracted to complete the engineering, acquire the necessary permit approvals, and prepare the tender documents. Tenders closed on Wednesday March 31, 2021. There were two (2) tender submissions.

#### **Analysis**:

Staff from BM Ross and Associates reviewed the two (2) tender submissions for completeness and accuracy and are recommending that the Municipality award the contract to Kurtis Smith Excavating Inc. in the amount of \$808,854 (including HST). A start date has not yet been provided.

The approved Capital Budget for the reconstruction of George Street, including road rehabilitation, stormwater, sanitary sewer, and watermain replacement was \$875,000 combined. The work was split between Public Works and Utility capital projects. The lowest tender submission was from Kurtis Smith Excavating Inc. in the amount of \$808,854 (including HST).
