#### **Background:**

The Municipality of Brockton applied to the Community, Culture and Recreation infrastructure funding stream of the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program (ICIP) to construct a 1,583 sq. ft. accessible washroom, changeroom and concession building at the Bruce Power Regional Soccer Park in the East Ridge Business Park.

#### **Analysis**:

Staff are pleased to report that the Municipality of Brockton's application has been approved, and Brockton will be receiving \$352,032 from the federal government and \$293,331 from the provincial government towards this project. Staff have started planning for the project and expect construction for the initial site servicing to begin in the fall of 2021. This project is very exciting and will support healthy active living for a large number of our residents and youth development throughout Brockton.
