At its February 12, 2018 meeting, Brockton Council reviewed a staff report in response to correspondence from Cindy Coville of Chepstow (see enclosed) who expressed safety concerns regarding the conditions of the roads and sidewalks that her children travel to and from their home in Chepstow and their bus stop at Mary Immaculate School.
