Chepstow has had significant snow on the ground for about two weeks now and last week the sidewalks were poorly plowed and in some cases not done at all and some places still have yet to be touched. The sidewalk from the main street to the catholic school was not plowed for the kids to use it in the mornings and my son who gets pushed in a wheelchair (or uses his scooter) when he volunteers at the school two days a week had to access the school by using the road. The sidewalk from the mill to the mailboxes at the hall only had about 30 feet plowed and I believe that part was done by one of the home owners along the road, the rest of the time I had to walk very close to oncoming traffic and sometimes I was walking on the actual road itself by the narrow parts of the road. I hope we can work something out soon before someone gets hurt, I have talked with neighbours around town who regularly walk and they are concerned someone will end up slipping on the ice or get hurt by the amount of traffic on the road. I also encouraged them to contact Brockton council about their concerns.
