### **Report:**

#### Background:

The Municipality of Brockton has many volunteers that contribute to making Brockton a wonderful place to live, work and play. Brockton implemented a Committee of Council Volunteer Recognition Policy on May 14, 2019 as per By-Law 2019-039. In accordance with the policy, the Municipality would normally host a BBQ in May at the Walkerton Community Centre to recognize Committee members, but unfortunately, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the event did not occur in 2020.

#### Analysis:
