Report:

Background:

Staff have undergone two training sessions on Brockton's updated Purchasing and Procurement Policy as well as the Procedure guide and templates. In addition, Council participated in one training session tailored to their positions and role in municipal procurement.

As per the Municipality of Brockton's Purchasing and Procurement Policy requirement to report purchasing results over \$25,000.00 to Council for information purposes.

The Recreation department issued formal Request for Quotation (RFQ) #REC2021-01 – Centennial Park Pool Roof Resurfacing project.

A formal RFQ was issued and forwarded to qualified area vendors by invite only on Monday May 3, 2021 and closed on Friday May 14, 2021 2:00 p.m. Four (4) quote bids were received from local or regional commercial roofing companies that ranged from \$25,500.00 to \$66,500.00. All quotations met the requirements of the RFQ specifications. The recommended quote was reviewed and approved by the CFO. The lowest quotation of \$25,500.00 + HST inclusive of full installation was accepted from Wilken Roofing and Sheet Metal of Hanover.

Analysis:

The formal RFQ provided competitive results from reputable vendors. Installation is anticipated to be completed on or before June 25, 2021. Contractors schedules are considerably busy due to the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic on the supply chain and ongoing building boom.
